There are two choices for creating image files: Open up your image editor (any one will do; we recommend either GIMP or Photoshop, because that's what we use), click the "File" tab, and select "Save As." Then, in the Save As dialogue box, choose from the file formats listed on the left, and then select the "Format" tab to determine what type of image file you want to create, and choose an appropriate name. Then click the "Save" button, and we hope that you now have your image files! While this is not the fastest and easiest process, and certainly not the most intuitive, most major software packages are not going to change the way that they work when you import your image files. Furthermore, this is probably the least expensive, least time consuming way to create image files, and it's pretty much foolproof. Importing your image files Now that you have your image files, you need to import them into the computer. The process of importing is fairly simple. Once your image files have been downloaded, opened, and saved on the computer, you need to find the place where the image files were stored. This is sometimes going to be something that you cannot access directly (it may be buried in a subfolder, or it may be hidden behind the scenes); you will have to do a little digging, and we can't help you with that, but basically, you just need to

look for the folder that the image files are in. Once you've found that folder, you will need to find the right folder within it. Again, we cannot tell you how to do this (because we don't know which folder holds your image files), but you need to find the folder that holds all the image files that you want to import. You may need to look in your computer's documents, or your software's documents, or in your image folder. Whatever you do, you need to find that folder; and you may need to make another folder in order to make sure that your image files are organized in the proper place. Once you've found that folder, you will then need to move all the image files that you want to import into that folder. Once you've got the image files in that folder, you can import the files by selecting them, and choosing the "Import" option from the file menu.
